

Interventions in the Quilliams Floodplain

Drone_QuilliamsIn 2015, Renaissance Brome Lake carried out an important rehabilitation project in the Quilliams floodplain. The task was to redo the bank that had been decimated by a water crossing, put in an ecological bridge and renaturalise the bank itself, along a distance of some 1.6 km. The goal of these substantial upgrades was to improve the habitat of the species found in this area and to improve the quality of the water in both the brook and the lake.



On December 15 2015, thanks to QuebecPanorama.com, we were able to capture some impressive images of the restoration site and the scope of the work that had taken place. These drone-taken images give a very good idea of the work done. The projet will be completed in 2016.
